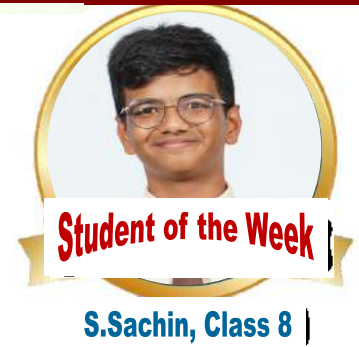

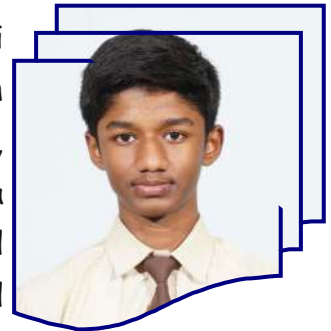

22nd year of BOOK FESTIVAL INAUGURATION AT SATCHIDANANDA 17-04-2025

To instil in the growing years of student's life the importance of reading, Satchidananda Jothi Nikethan International School, Kallar organized a book fair from April, 17, 2025 to April 19, 2025 in their school premises benefitting the student and the staff community.

The three-day **Book Fair** was organised in the school auditorium to enhance the literary skills and inculcate good reading habits among students. Adhering to the adage, 'Today's Reader is Tomorrow's Leader', the school organizes this book fair every year to create voracious readers.

The Book Fair was formally inaugurated by Dr.M.S.Muthusamy, IPS, Inspector -General of Police (Retd), Chennai. In his inaugural speech, the Chief Guest said, "Children of this school stand unique. What I like most in them is their humility. The purpose of reading books is not to make people knowledgeable but to make human a humane ultimately". While differentiating intuition from knowledge, he was very clear on how intuition brings harmony in mind, body and soul. Further, while congratulating the prize winners, he narrated how books connect people. The book 'Ennamae Vazhvu' written by Abdul Raheem transformed A.P.J. Abdul Kalam from a human to a scholar.

The Book Fair has created great interest and enthusiasm among the students. The students are exposed to as many as one lakh books displayed by various publications such as Scholastic Scholars, Adithi Books, Ramakrishna Mission, New Century Book House, Vijaya Pathipagam, Kavin Publication and Red Books.

The students had the experience to choose their own books under the guidance of their teachers. They picked books varying from science to fiction; from puzzles to poems; drawing to creative writing fiction to non-fiction. Every stall was very impressive and both the children and teachers enjoyed purchasing their favourite books. The fair was open to the parents also.

Dr.Kavidasan, the Secretary of the school spoke how reading books would bring a new chapter in their lives and how the leaders have become great because of cultivating reading habits in them from their younger days. Inauguration of the Model Post Office by Satchidananda Stamp Club

On April 17, 2025, the Satchidananda Stamp Club proudly inaugurated a Model Post Office at the School Auditorium, with Shri R. Pattabiraman, Superintendent of Post for the Tirupur Division of the Tamil Nadu Circle, serving as the chief guest for the event.

The Model Post Office featured five counters, where students enthusiastically explained various services offered by the Department of Post, including speed post, registered post, my stamp, philately, postal savings, India Post Payments Bank (IPPB), insurance, business development, Aadhaar services, e-post, direct post, and media post.

A highlight of the event was the Philatelic Exhibitions, showcasing a diverse range of thematic collections. These included displays on famous personalities, the Ramayana and Mahabharata, the First World War, Nature, Cartoons, Yoga, Suryanamaskar, Indians in the First World War, the Solar System, Handicrafts, Handlooms, Architecture, Headgears, Pictorial Cancellations, Astrological Signs, and Notable Figures like Abdul Kalam and Mahatma Gandhi. Additionally, Numismatics, Post Crossing, and Personalized Stamps were integral parts of the Model Post Office inauguration.

During his address, Shri. Pattabiraman, commended the Management for fostering a love for philately among students. He highlighted that Satchidananda is unique in maintaining a 100% Philatelic Deposit Account for the past 24 years. He elaborated on the extensive network of post offices across the country and how these institutions benefit the public through various government schemes, from Kashmir to Kanyakumari. He also emphasized the multifaceted role of post offices in providing banking services, insurance, logistics, and investment opportunities.

Dr. Kavidasan, the Secretary, encouraged students to aspire to join the Indian Postal Service (IPS) and serve the community. He urged them to write letters to their parents, friends, and relatives, emphasizing the sentimental value of preserving such correspondence as

cherished memories. He also recommended that students visit their local post office for educational purposes and encouraged them to start their own stamp collections to enhance their general knowledge, stay informed about world affairs, and learn the history behind stamps.

To further support the community, an Aadhar camp was organized for the benefit of teaching and non-teaching staff, as well as students. Club members also took the opportunity to purchase philatelic stationery, including miniature sheets, first day covers, special covers, and commemorative stamps, to enrich their collections and deepen their engagement with the world of philately.

The event was a resounding success, inspiring students to explore the fascinating world of postal services and philately while fostering a sense of community and historical awareness. Mr.P.Rajasekar, Department of Mathematics organised the entire programme.
