**All India CBSE Hockey Tournament****October 10 to 16, 2025****Satchidananda Jothi Nikethan International School Wins Second Place**

Satchidananda Jothi Nikethan International School has achieved a remarkable feat by securing Second Place in the All India CBSE Hockey Championship in the Under-17 Boys category.

The All India CBSE Hockey Championship was held at Oriental Public School, Bhopal, from October 10 to 16. In the Under-17 category, eight teams from across India – all winners of their respective zonal-level tournaments – participated in the national finals.

Having clinched the First Place in the CBSE South Zone-1 Hockey Tournament (Under-17 category) hosted by Satchidananda Jothi Nikethan International School, the school's Under-14, Under-17, and Under-19 boys' teams qualified to participate in the All-India finals.

In the Under-17 boys' category, the Satchidananda Jothi Nikethan team performed outstandingly in the league matches, defeating teams from SS Modasing Model School, Delhi, Sanjeevan Public School, Maharashtra, and IADV School, Indore, to enter the semifinals. In the semifinals, they triumphed over Sunway School, Rampur, to secure a place in the grand finals. In the final match, they narrowly missed the championship title, finishing as Runners-up against Khalsa Academy School, Amritsar. The school's Under-14 and Under-19 boys' teams also excelled, finishing in Third Place at the national level.

At the valedictory ceremony, Mr. Alok Sharma, Honourable Member of Parliament (Lok Sabha), Bhopal, and Dr. Kavidasan, Secretary of Satchidananda Jothi Nikethan International School, presented the trophy and medals to the winning teams and congratulated them on their outstanding performance.

The session was highly beneficial for our teachers, equipping them with knowledge of new tools to integrate AI into their teaching practices effectively.
