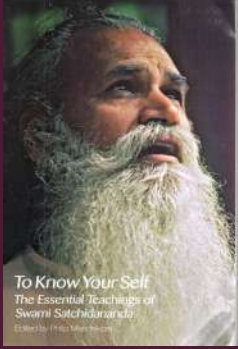

Staff Skill Enrichment Programme – 2025**June 02 to 06, 2025**

Satchidananda Jothi Nikethan International School conducted a dynamic Staff Skill Enrichment programme for its faculty members from June 2, 2025, to June 6, 2025. This annual skill development programme aims to boost the energy level and acumen of teacher educators.

In his inaugural address, the Secretary of the school, Dr. Kavidasan emphasized the importance of 7 core values - Personal Values, Family Values, Professional Values, Social Values, National Values, Global Values & National Values, to be successful in life and categorized individuals into four types: stars with high potential and high performance, problem makers with high potential and low performance, dead woods with low potential and low performance, and workaholics with low potential and high performance.

On June 3, 2025, Dr. V. Ganesan, the Academic Advisor, presented a session on 'Learn more; Do more; Become more ... and Inspire', focusing on self-awareness, knowledge expansion, and thoughtfulness. He introduced innovative feedback mechanisms like "Fingers of Clarity" and encouraged inquiry-based learning through the "Question Wall."

In the afternoon session, Mrs. Hema from Ebix Smart Class demonstrated how smart boards can make learning more interactive, accessible, and aligned with modern educational needs.

On June 4, 2025, all the teachers participated in three online sessions on 'Project Child Against Child Abuse', gaining insights into dealing with peer pressure, academic pedagogy, and school child protection policy.

In the following day, Ms. V. Steffina Rose, Advocate, discussed POCSO and POSH, highlighting the importance of protecting women and children from sexual harassment. Key points included

the POSH Act (2013) and POCSO Act (2012), the role of Internal Complaints Committees, mandatory reporting of child abuse cases, and protection of child identity in media and court proceedings.

On June 5 and 6, Mr. Chandra Mohan presented sessions on "Theater Education", exploring drama's role in teaching and learning. He demonstrated how theatre can engage students and make learning fun and interactive through activities like acting out the Jalian Wallah Massacre and teaching renewable and non-renewable energy concepts. The session highlighted theatre's potential as an inexpensive and practical teaching tool, promoting creativity and student participation.

Overall, the Staff Skill Enrichment programme successfully enhanced the skills and knowledge of faculty members, fostering a culture of innovation, creativity, and excellence.

The programme's diverse sessions and activities equipped educators with practical tools and strategies to promote student engagement, well-being, and academic success. We thank our Management for providing this wonderful opportunity to enhance our skills.

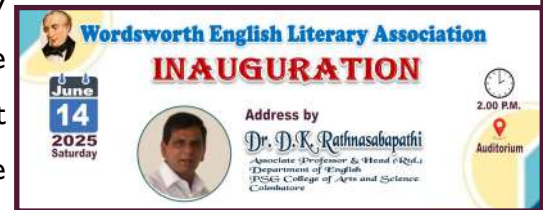
