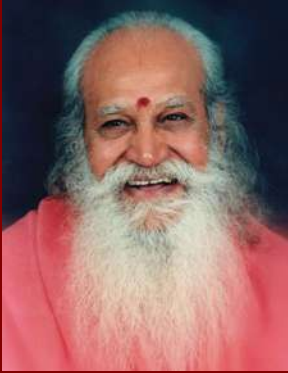

## Educationa Field Trip : Class VIII : A Journey of Discovery July 03 to 05, 2025

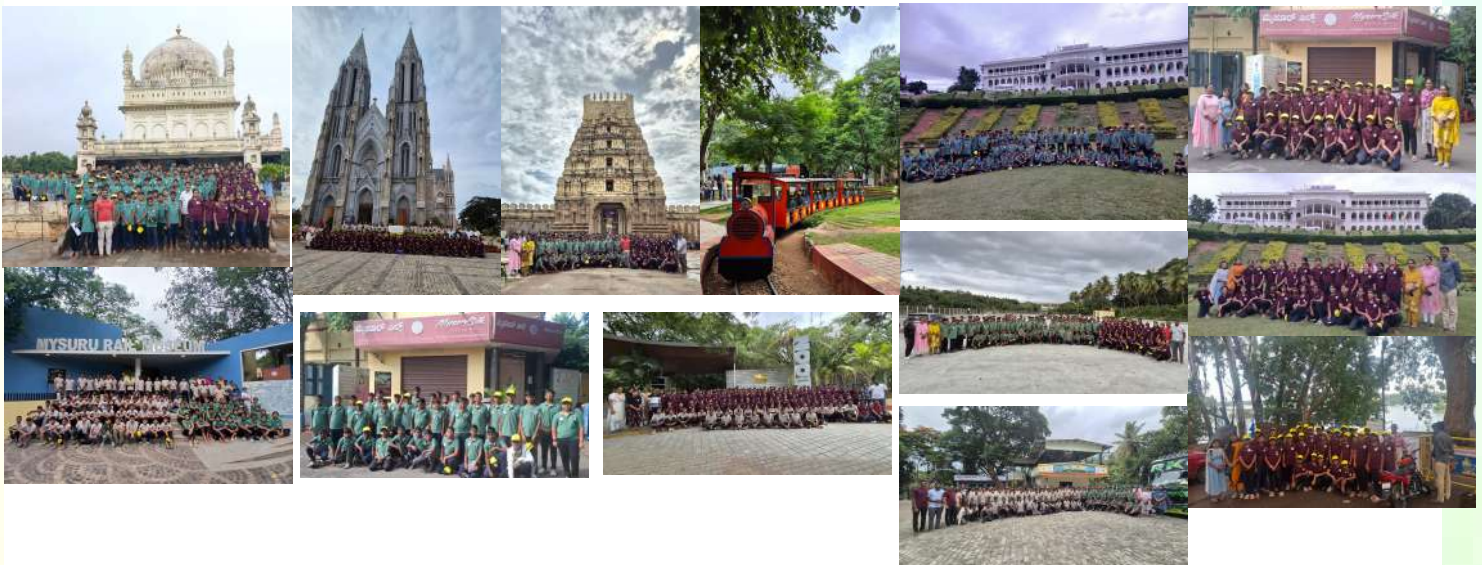

## Educational Field Trip to Mudumalai : Class IX : Wild Wonders and Tribal Tales July 03 to 05, 2025

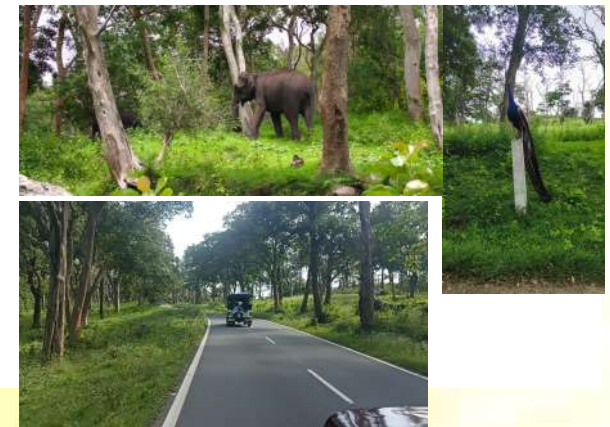

The session was informative and engaging, allowing the students to gain a deeper understanding of the significance of healthy habits in their daily lives.

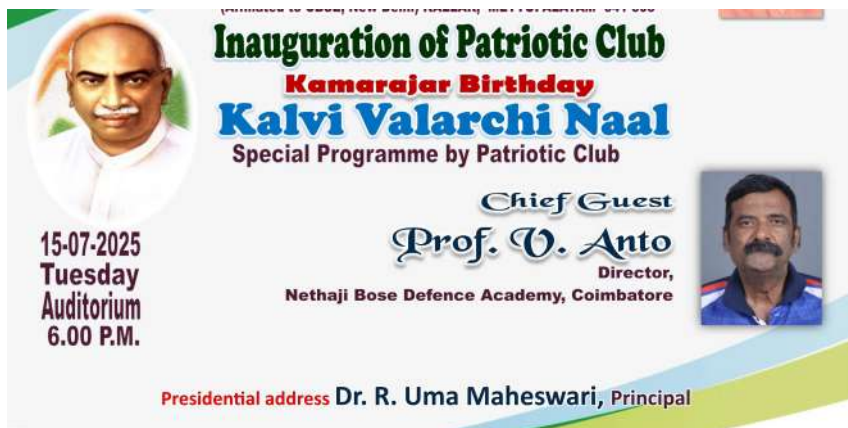


## Children Visited Traffic Safety Park July 01, 02 & 10, 2025
