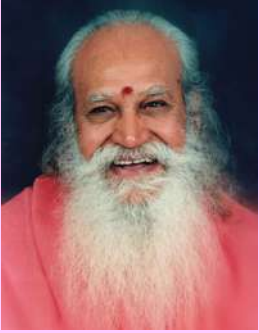

We Educate the Mind; Illuminate the Soul

Awareness Program on POCSO July 17, 2025

On July 17, 2025, our school's POCSO committee members conducted an awareness program on the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act, 2012, for non-teaching staff. The program aimed to educate staff on the Act's provisions, recognize signs of sexual abuse in children, and inform them about procedures for reporting suspected cases.

The session highlighted CBSE directives on strict compliance with the POCSO Act through measures like gender sensitization and awareness sessions. Dr.R.Uma Maheswari, Principal and Mr. K. Karunanithi, Teacher of Tamil, emphasized the importance of POCSO awareness in creating a safer learning environment and empowering staff to handle sensitive situations.

The program enabled staff to gain knowledge on handling disclosures and ensured compliance with legal requirements under the POCSO Act. By conducting such awareness programs, our school reinforces its commitment to child safety and well-being.



Dental Screening

On July 20, 2025, a dental screening was conducted for 127 students of classes IX to XII to promote oral health awareness among the students. The primary objective of this screening was to identify any potential dental issues and provide necessary recommendations for treatment or preventive care. Dr.Ajaykumar Sachdev, M.D.S, Consultant Orthodontist, Dental Surgeon & Implantologist, and his team from Coimbatore conducted the screening.

A total of 133 staff members underwent blood tests (Hb) and urine routine tests. CBSE Capacity Building Programme on Critical and Creative Thinking July 25 & 26, 2025

“Critical thinking is the compass that guides its direction and Creativity is the spark that ignites innovation. Together, they illuminate the path to new possibilities.”

Our school hosted a two-day Capacity Building Programme for teachers of CBSE Schools on July 25 & 26, 2025 on the theme “Critical and Creative Thinking”, organized by Center of Excellence, Chennai. Mrs. Shalini Nair, Principal, Kikani Global Academy School, Coimbatore and Mrs. Subbulakshmi.V, Principal, Geethanjali All India Senior Secondary School, Erode were the CBSE resource persons. The experts imparted their knowledge, insights, and viewpoints about Critical and Creative Thinking Skills. The workshop was not just about absorbing information; it’s about engaging in a collaborative learning journey where each of them had something valuable to contribute.

On day one, the resource persons delved into the fundamentals of critical thinking, exploring techniques and strategies that helped them analyze information more effectively, generate innovative ideas, and approach problems from fresh perspectives. Through engaging activities, group discussions, and practical exercises, the educators enhanced their understanding of the practical skills that they can apply in their daily lives. Teachers were encouraged to use different strategies like Webb’s Depth of Knowledge Framework, Bloom’s Taxonomy, Claim/Support/Question – a reasoning routine, Argumentation challenges strategy etc., to create the interest of students in the class.

On day two, the educators learned the use of combining critical and creative thinking to create a dynamic intellectual framework, enabling individuals to approach challenges with both analytical rigor and imaginative flair. Types of Creative Thinking, Blocks to Creativity, Lateral Thinking, Problem Based Learning, Design Thinking Approach and Brainstorming were some of the concepts which were thoroughly discussed by the resource persons.

Throughout the two-day workshop, all the educators actively participated, asked questions, and shared their insights and experiences with one another. By the end of the second day, the educators walked away feeling inspired, empowered, and equipped with the tools they needed to navigate the complexities of our ever-changing world with confidence and creativity.



Mass Book Reading

July 27, 2025

Our school organized a Mass Book Reading event on July 27, 2025, with the aim of fostering a love for literature and promoting the joy of reading among students. The event witnessed enthusiastic participation from over 800 students from grades 4 to 12 accompanied by teachers and school authorities who gathered to read simultaneously for about an hour.

The Chief Guest was Mr. Lakoka N. Subramaniam, Chairman, M/s Sagotharen, Coimbatore. The Chief Guest, in his address shared his personal journey of falling in love with books and developing into a passionate reader. He emphasized that consistent reading is the key to leading a successful life and contributing to the progress of the nation. He also reminded the students that even a single sentence can ignite a spark of inspiration.

In his address, Dr. Kavidasan, the Secretary of the school, highlighted that the root of many societal challenges lies in the lack of knowledge. 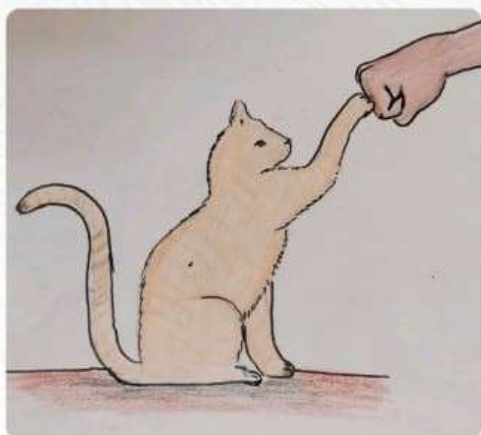

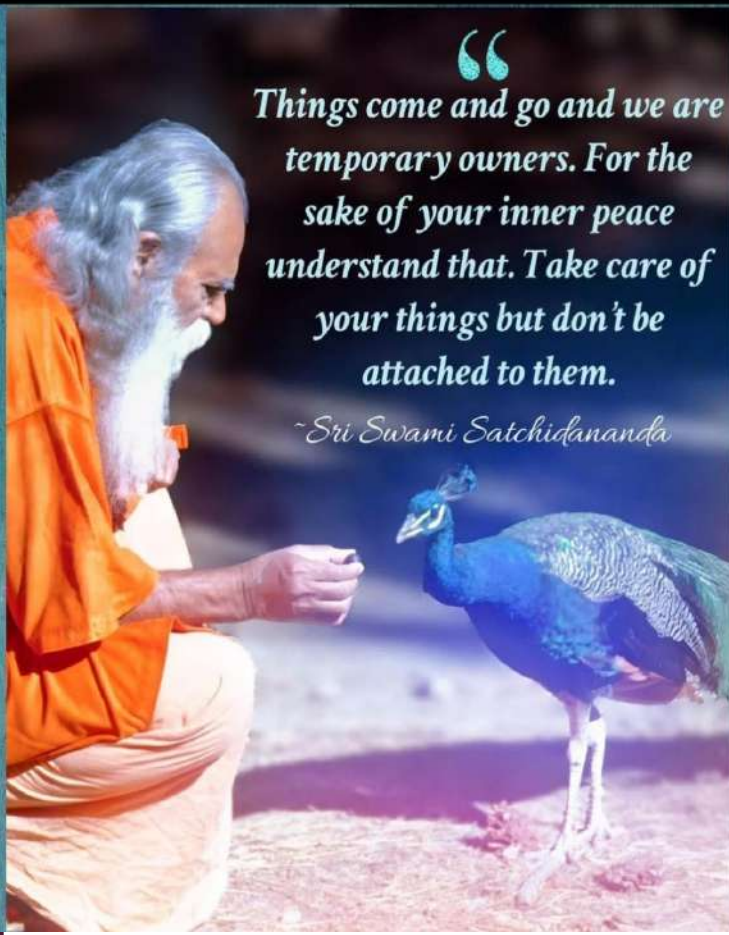
